The tomatoes

Tomatoes from Mexico is coming to an end. New crops from Florida have started since the 3rd week of March and the market appears to be decreasing. This region will give us more volume and prices should be affordable for the whole month of April. Only the temperature could change the forecast.





The peppers

Several producers of green peppers in Florida should give us good volumes for the month of April. Prices seem to lower. The season of green peppers from Mexico is coming to an end. It is difficult to predict how the Florida market will react. Mother Nature can affect prices.

The cucumbers

English cucumbers are produced in greenhouses in Leamington, Ontario. The warm weather and a higher sunshine rate contributes significantly to the growth of cucumbers. The quality is excellent and the prices should be stable for the entire month of April. Only the Easter period could affect prices because of increased demand.



The onions

The quality of red onions is very good but prices seem to rise. April is the last month we will receive onions from Oregon. We will then come from California. New crops are scheduled for May.



Transportation

Transportation costs remain high. The oil is increasing and export of products from Quebec is at its lowest because of the parity of the U.S. dollar. Truck demand remains the same but they are less available. This is the law of supply and demand.
