Information on the products

The tomatoes

From now on, temperatures have been favorable in Florida. Tomatoes come with excellent quality. Producers in North Florida (Palmetto et Ruskin) are about to complete their harvest (2nd and 3rd picking). They provide a larger volume of small tomatoes, that are the 6X7 ones. Overall, the market appears to be declining for the month of January if temperatures remain favorable.





The peppers

In late December, we experienced a decline in the market. Nothing makes us believe that an increase is coming. In recent years, Florida and Mexico have experienced very cold temperatures in January. If it happens again this year, there could be a shortage of product, as well as a price increase. But let's remain positive, for the moment, the market is low and the quality is good.

The cucumbers

Currently, the majority of English Cucumbers come from Mexico. There is no overabundance and markets remain quite high. The quality is generally good. We expect very low volumes of English Cucumbers from Ontario's greenhouses in late January.



The onions

Our red onions come from Oregon. So far, the quality is good. According to a note sent by the producers of Oregon, it is possible that some batches are presenting internal rotting caused by the temperatures they suffered. We remain positive because we have not been informed of any case until now.



Transport

Transport has not been easy during the holiday season. The demand was strong and the trucks were less available. Transport costs have increased significantly. This market is expected to return to the decrease at the end of this period.
