**The tomatoes**

California offers tomatoes until mid-October. The quality is not at its best and the life span is less. Virginia should begin their 2nd harvest. They have smaller fruit size 6X7 available and the quality is very good. The two markets have equivalent prices. Tomatoes from Georgia began the last week of September and they are at the beginning, they only offer larger tomatoes. As the season progresses, they will have smaller fruits. According to our information, tomatoes from Florida are scheduled to begin in mid-October for the regions of Ruskin and Palmetto.





## The peppers

If Mother Nature permits, we will have local green peppers until mid-October. We expect the market to rise due to the colder temperature and the end of the season as there will be less volume available. Subsequently, we will get them from Georgia.

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## The cucumbers

The quality of the English cucumbers is excellent. The price has remained fairly stable. By cons, since the summer season is over and the temperatures decrease and the amount of sunshine is less, it is possible that it affects the rising market.



## The onions

The origin of the red onions have changed since the last week of September. They came from California for the month of October, we will now receive the new crop from Oregon.
