INFORMATIONS ON THE PRODUCTS:

TOMATOES:

In the beginning of June, we will receive the new crops from Ruskin in Florida. Prices will be lower. The quality has improved compared to what was received lately but can not be described as excellent.

Harvests of Quincy, North Florida, as well as those of South Carolina should start around the 12th or 14th of June until mid-July. At this time, we move to the new crops of Virginia.



THE PEPPERS

We are currently receiving the peppers from northern Florida. Their quality is excellent. The new crop from northern Georgia will begin June 8th followed by the region of North Carolina in late June.



THE CUCUMBERS



They will come from greenhouses in Leamington, Ontario. The prices are fairly stable and their quality is amazing.

THE ONIONS

They are from California and their quality is amazing. On the other hand, they have very low volumes due to the fact that Texas and Mexico offer at the same time and that due to heavy rains they have received recently, Mexico is self-sufficient and encroaches on Texas' crops. This increases the demand from California.



THE TRANSPORTATION



Prices for transportation are rising and this is related to the price of fuel and the lack of export. This lowers truck for the return of the United States.
