INFORMATION ON THE PRODUCE:

TOMATOES:

Currently, the largest tomato producer is Florida and there were recently two freezing periods , the weeks of December 06th and Dec. 13th. Temperatures have reached -4 degrees Celsius. The volumes are very down and markets are rising. In addition, younger plants planned for the picking in mid-January, were damaged. The cold weather prevented pollination and flowering plants. It is therefore expected that low volumes will be available at this time. Usually, tomatoes from Mexico are available but the country has also experienced cold temperatures, just like Florida.
