Information on the products

The tomatoes

Cool temperatures undergoing in Mexico have slowed the growth of their tomatoes therefore there is less volume in this region. Because of their reduced products, there is no pressure on Florida producers who have fewer and fewer small tomatoes (6X6 and 6X7). The market is therefore rising but we expect that by mid-March, it will be down.





The peppers

Florida has had some problems with insects in their fields for about one month. The situation seems resolved. The quality of green peppers is better but the market is a bit high. As soon as the volumes in Mexico are down, we expect a price increase of green peppers from the U.S. east coast.

The cucumbers

Greenhouses in Leamington, Ontario are producing more and more local cucumbers. The sunshine rate is higher as the days lengthen and warm weather contributes to better productions. We can predict a better market for the month of March due to increases in volumes to come.



The onions

Our red onions come from Oregon and their quality is excellent. All production areas have excess inventory and keep prices low.



Transportation

We should expect an increase in transportation costs. The price of oil continues to rise and pump prices are affected. In addition, the Canadian dollar is at par and the U.S. economic crisis slowed export causing a shortage of trucks to bring our products. It is a market of supply and demand, so prices of transport can be increased.
